

Do I as a scientist have to consider the Nagoya Protocol?

Short Answer

The requirements for provenience, transfer, access, and the utilization of genetic resources ([Nagoya Protocol](#)) do also apply for basic scientific research.

Detailed Answer

Genetic material that was collected prior to December 29, 1993, is not subject to international laws on biodiversity.
